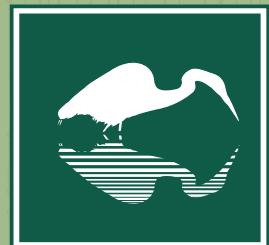


Deer Creek Hills Preserve

Sat. February 18, 2017
7:00am to Noon

Join Sacramento Valley Conservancy docents for a birding outing at Deer Creek Hills Preserve - Upland Birding / Great Backyard Bird Count 2017 activity. The hike is in the open grasslands of the preserve. Last year's highlight was a Grasshopper Sparrow (on February 20th). We will view the large pond to look for American Widgeon, Wood Ducks, Ring-necked Ducks and Teal, in addition to the lovely Red-winged Black Bird residents. We can almost guarantee nice views of Rock Wrens, Horned Larks, Savannah Sparrows, Say's Phoebe and American Kestrel. Eagle sightings are common along with Northern Harrier and occasionally we get a Rough-legged Hawk or Ferruginous Hawk sighting. Loggerhead Shrike, Prairie Falcon or Peregrine Falcon and even coyotes are possibilities too. We strive for good looks at the birds for all participants.
