4:00pm to 5:30pm –Overnight Camper Check-in

We recommend you arrive and check-in with time to set up your tent prior to dinner. Overnight Campers vehicle permits will be given out at registration. Please keep vehicle permits on your front dash with your last name and phone number visible.

Activities start at 4:00pm and continue until 9:30pm. 10pm is Quiet Time. Please pitch TENTS in the designated camping areas.



Dinner service begins at **5:30pm** and will conclude by 6:30pm.

CAMP POLLOCK

Rules for Overnight Glamping:

1. Camp Pollock is managed by the Sacramento Valley Conservancy and is open to the public from Sunrise to Sunset every day of the week.
2. Automobiles in parking lot only. **NO DRIVING ON THE LAWN or courtyard.**
3. Please carry camping equipment to campsite, SVC provides wheelbarrows for transporting gear.
4. **Travel and Camp on Durable Surfaces.**
5. **Campfire Permits** are required for open fires, such as campfires, barbecues and portable stoves. Propane stoves okay. Due to drought conditions, no site campfires are allowed. SVC will facilitate the event campfire for Glamp Out in the courtyard.
6. Water available, but not at individual sites. Please provide the ability to transport water. **Plan Ahead and Prepare.**
7. Showers available.
8. Picnic tables are first come, first served.
9. No electricity access for campsites.
10. Limited parking; carpooling encouraged for large groups.
11. **No RV or vehicle Camping; no camping in Parking Lot.**
12. **No alcohol permitted in campsites.**
13. Pack It In, Pack It Out & Leave No Trace ethics should be practiced.
14. Youth must be chaperoned by an adult at all times.
15. **Pets must be leashed at all times.** You must supply your own resources to clean up after your pet and practice **Leave No Trace: Dispose of Waste Properly, Respect Wildlife and Be Considerate of Other Visitors.**
16. Launching of canoes and kayaks is allowed, but no improved facility. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. Swimming allowed. All water users MUST wear life vests at all times. NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY.
17. Anyone who violates any of the rules for camping will be directed to leave Camp Pollock. No refunds.
18. Sacramento county rangers lock the gates at sunset and SVC will unlock the gates at sunrise. If vehicle access to or from the Camp Pollock parking lot is required before or after daylight hours, please make special arrangements with SVC in advance.
